






#### **EDUCATION**

### HEALTH CARE

NSNT has been running a medicine centre named EK UMEED w.e.f. 07.02.2009 in the premises of Civil Hospital, Ludhiana (PB), India. This centre is being taken care of by an M.B.B.S. doctor deployed by Nikhil Singal Noble Trust (Regd). The trust is providing free medicines to all the indoor patients of the Civil Hospital. It also shifts chronic patients of the same to private hospitals and helps them in their treatment. This trust also provides medical equipments used for the patients in Orthopedics & Eye Department respectively.
