Spot Light Villa Community Organization was established in 2018 when a group of seven seniors ages 25 to 60 wanted to create a place with activities and support services that would cater to the specific needs of people living with poverty. Today, we are over three hundred active members.

"The mission of our center is to fight poverty, improve and maintain a healthy and independent lifestyle and to improve their quality of life.

Our four-pronged purpose is as follows:

- 1. Promote dignity and self-esteem.
- 2. Foster independence and self-determination.
- 3. Facilitate social interaction and involvement in community life.
- Dispel stereotypes and myths about aging."

We operate a nonprofit multipurpose facility governed by an active 16-member volunteer board of directors, including three of the organization's founders. We offer a variety of programs at our center to meet the needs of those we serve.

"Programs include:

- Preventive health care and education
- Nutritious in-center and home-delivered meals
- Crisis intervention, support groups, and case management
- Legal and insurance counseling
- Housing assistance
- Employment training and information
- Transportation, leisure activities, recreation
- Volunteerism/placement, social services, and referral information

Our multi-use facility makes us unique from other senior centers in Any County and allows us to play an even more vital role in our community.
