How will we help you?

1. Before arrival

- Post a volunteer project on your behalf. Tell us about your need and we'll help you get the word out.
- Screen and pre-selection of the professional volunteer according to project needs.
- Provide you the signed Volunteer agreement, volunteer background and reference check.
- Advise volunteer on pre-departure logistics.



2. On arrival

- Pick up volunteer from the airport.
- Support with the introduction and orientation of professionals.
- Cultural Orientation, Code of conduct, Child Protection; Safety and Security training.
- Assistance for clarifying the project goals and outcomes with the professional volunteer.

3. During service

- Periodical check-ins for quality control on both sides.
- Support and mediation in the event of challenging situations.

4. After

- Post-service survey (exchange of feedback, sharing of experience).
- Evaluation of project.

Do I have to pay a project fee for service?

We provide our support pro-bono to non-profit-organizations.

Who can submit a project on Professionals doing good?

Professionals doing good only provides support to socially conscious organizations (i.e. Association, Foundation, Government, Nonprofit, Responsible Business, Social Enterprise) who are able to provide evidence of their social impact on the community and demonstrates ethical behavior.

Therefore, your organization can participate if the following are true and can provide evidence (amongst other things) about it:

- Can be defined as providing a social impact on the community
- Can give evidence of ethical conduct or behavior
- Based or operating in Cambodia
- Regularly registered (in the process of being registered) either in Cambodia and/or abroad
- Have website and/or a social media presence



How to become a PdG host organization?

To apply and become a Professionals doing good hosting organization and have the services described above, all you have to do is to

1. Read and sign our MOU.
2. Agree on the Job Description for the volunteer project.

- There are no strings attached to becoming a host organization. It is a just step required to ensure you have agreed with our service and are happy to work together and will be done only one-off.

What's next?

Once you have become a PdG Host Organization, we will work together to get your ideal professional doing good volunteer on board.
