About

Living Faith Society is a result of 20 years of grass-root ministry experience in India. We're a registered non-profit, development organisation Society under the Societies Registration Act 1860 located in Lucknow, U.P., India, directly benefiting underprivileged children and their families every year, through various welfare projects on education, healthcare, livelihood and women empowerment, in remote villages and slums across 4 districts of Uttar Pradesh.

Our overall goal is the empowerment of women and girls from poor and marginalised communities leading to improvement in their lives and livelihoods.

Why Women and Girls?

Living Faith Society focuses on the empowerment of women and girls because they are disproportionately affected by poverty and discrimination; and suffer abuse and violations in the realisation of their rights, entitlements and access and control over resources. Experience shows that, when equipped with the proper resources, women have the power to help whole families and entire communities overcome poverty, marginalisation and social injustice.

There are two key reasons why we work with women and girls:

Women and girls are disproportionately affected by poverty and discrimation.

Lack of education for girls contributes to early marriage, higher birth rates, and lower income. Discriminatory laws prohibit women from owning or inheriting property,

holding bank account: , or prosecuting abusers.

Girls face the greatest r sk, as they often have no choice but to leave school so they can help their family earn money, find food, look after younger siblings, collect water, and run the household while their paren's work.

Women and girls are an important part the solutions needed to truly overcome poverty.

Women tend to transfer improvements in their own lives into the lives of their children, families and communities. To ensure this happens, we promote savings and provide women with small loans so they can turn their talents into businesses.

Programs

For an emerging country like India, development of underprivileged children holds the key to the progress of the nation itself, and their education is the cornerstone of this progress. But education for children cannot be achieved without ensuring the welfare of the family – a child can go to school regularly only when the family, particularly the mother is healthy and empowered; the family has decent livelihood opportunities and a steady income.

Realizing this, Living Faith Society, beginning in the corridors of education, has adopted a life cycle approach with intensive programmes focussed on family health, livelihood and women empowerment, which address the needs of children, their families and the larger community.

Education

The programme selects girls based on multiple criteria family income, parents' educational background, social beckground and the child's aptitude. A comprehensive sponsorship is created to take care of a range of their educational requirements, providing not only academic support that enables them to make a success of their schooling experience but also material support including uniforms, school bags, shoes, socks etc. to enable the girl child to go to school with dignity. Our eam also works closely with parents and the community to sensitize them on gender equity, the importance of education and changes they will witness in girls with education.

Empowerment of Women

Women folk are very important groups in the activities of micro and macro income generating activities. We provide various trade skills and develop their traditional trades including Tailoring, Computer courses and Beautician courses and also develop their basic business skills and encourage small savings for the emergencies of their life.

Health

Living Faith Society conducts various free health checkup camps, eye camps, related health campaigns awareness programmes in different villages and issues free medicines.

It aims to create health awareness among the under-privileged children and needy young women, for a healthy life.
