1. ABOUT ACTS COUNCELOR TANZANIA.

The organization is a Tanzanian non-profit organization geared for general development and ethics for a better Community. The organization was registered in October, 12 / 2012 with registration No. OOngo/OO05854, though it started to operate 2009 the organization (as per its mission, vision and objectives) enable citizens to realize their economic social and political potentials for improving social development by fighting poverty social evils such as drug – abuse excessive drunkenness etc thus achieve better quality of life.

Thus ACTS undertakings in Geita (and) Tanzania in general since then till this material time is to enable the local population (mainly at grass root levels) to know and realize the ill-consequences of social misbehaviors, eg. Excessive drunkenness and drug – abuse etc so as to live under a developing life!

2. INTRODUCTION.

Many activities which was carried out by ACTS in six locations of Geita District in the year of 2014 (from Jan – Dec) which involved counseling conducting seminars establishing development projects e.g. forming youth and women development gropes etc is the continuation of social measures geared to help the local Communities to realize and understand the social hardships they face in their daily life and how to go about them in meaningful manner, but what institution or organization that can play part in bringing these required development changes? ACT find it self as part and that is why it acts so and will continue to do so!

3. <u>ACTIVITY OBJECTIVES.</u>

Activities carried by ACT in mentioned localities which included counseling HIV / AIDS victims and drug-abuse, and holding seminars and work shop and public meeting had been and still are being centered on NEED BASED APPROCH after a keen research on how big the problem / problems are.

Thus foremost ACT (in Geita Region) before carrying its activities it observes the following factors:

- a) Information and data collection: This involves internal and external analysis and learning on life style of local population in their different place and time as per social, geographical and political circumstances?
- b) Internal and External Consultation and validation: This involves stakeholder groups and ACTS staff members w9orking together e.g. in seminars and workshops etc and come out on what they agree upon as a remedy to the existing social problems of drug-abuse, excessive drunkenness and homeless children.
- c) ACTS Priority in its doings ranges from: Health, Education, Water and Sanitation, Poverty at family levels etc.
