Masud Parves Library is a heartfelt effort to support in achieving human resource development and promoting economic progress through providing educational supports to the less fortunate students primarily through facilitating access to information. Together with this, organizing educational events for students, and training programs for students, youth and farmers aims at assisting in their skills development. This way MPL envisions furthering the process of skilled manpower development to foster economic development in the region.

Introduction

"Masud Parves Library" is a non-profitable, non-political, voluntary, charitable, social, knowledge and information center. It started its activities, mainly through collecting funds, in March, 2011 when the founder was studying in University of Trento, Italy. Since then, it has been collecting money from friends around the world aiming to establish a library with modern facilities at Soalia village in Shyamnagar thana of Satkhira district, Bangladesh.

To contribute in human resource and economic development by providing educational logistics to the students and information for all aiming to achieve a stable economic growth to cope with the contemporary world, Masud Parves Library has set its objectives. Which are: a) to facilitate access to educational logistics for students and information for all, b) to organize educational events, c) to organize training programs for students, youths and farmers for their skill development, and d) to provide shelter during the natural disaster and when necessary.

Therefore, first, it realized to build a good structure which can sustain in natural disaster and can provide shelter for the people during the emergency time. Accordingly, it started construction work for building the structure on 20th May, 2012. GM Abrahim Hossain, Head Master of South Chotokupot Registered Primary School, put the foundation

stone of the library. Almost 15 villagers; including religious leaders, primary and high-school teachers, local government representatives, community people, and students were present on the first day of construction.

After starting construction, some desserts had been distributed to the villagers followed by a prayer to almighty Allah for its success. The building is still under construction.

Lack of books will no longer be an excuse The library addresses the difficulties facing many students in this village in continuing their education due to lack of academic books. The parents unable even to manage the daily meals for the children are rather helpless in providing for the textbooks. Given that the world is moving fast while the digital divide and knowledge divide is expanding at an alarming rate; the intention of the library is to facilitate access to information for these youngsters by arranging for as many academic books as would be possible into the library. Therefore, it hopes that lack of books will no longer be an excuse for the students' dropout in the village.

It also intends to appoint a librarian-teacher who will be responsible for helping the learning process of students unable to afford for private tuition. The library will be equipped with computers and an Internet connection, opening the students to the new world of knowledge, which it thinks will interest them and facilitate student centered learning.

Skill Development

Organizing educational events for students for expanding their knowledge, training programs on computer and internet for students and youths for their skill development, and training programs on agricultural production for farmers for raise in growth to ensure food security will be added one by one to the functions of the library.

The library will be operated by a committee of teachers from various schools, and the student class representative from each class from VI to X. This committee will decide on future activities of the library and will also be responsible for implementing them. In this way, leadership capabilities will grow in students from their childhood.

Conclusion

"Masud Parves Library" is deeply trying to help poor children and adolescents continuing their education. Additionally, this library will be used as a shelter center during emergencies in the region, e.g. disasters like floods and cyclones which are very common here. Thousands of people remained water-clogged in Shyamnagar Upazilla of Satkhira in the aftermath of Cyclone Aila's rampage through Bangladesh. Homes were washed away as well as numerous agricultural areas. Crops were damaged by the tidal surges in low-lying coastal areas and on offshore islands in the Bay of Bengal. Many donor organizations and local NGOs are still providing shelters, food, relief etc. in the areas, but none of them are working in education.

From the first day of construction, community people and students have been voluntarily working to build this library for their village. The founder convinced them to work together for the library as they will be the direct beneficiaries. He made them understand that establishing this library by involving all representatives from society can sustain the library, and trigger education, which, eventually, would promote local development in the region.

Although it still needs around tk 250,000 (nearly €2,500) to complete the building, the founder is hopeful, as before, that money will not be a problem. What he believes is that thinking for people and starting work towards their development is important.
