IYAU works with churches, human rights activists and defenders, schools, peer educators, community based groups, local governments, prisons, Police, Local leaders, health facilities, Community Volunteers and Community health extension workers.

We take critical steps to ensure sustainability and leave a lasting impact on every community we serve.
