We train them under the trees in the compound of the church. We do have 30 acres of customary land given for free for the construction of the vocational center and a Hospital for treating the poor community

No teachers houses, library, classrooms, dining hall, dormitories, stores to mention but a few. There are about 300 000 vulnerable children, orphans and youth not only in Barr Sub County, but in Lira District and the surrounding Districts of Northern Uganda who need training in vocational skill to be self reliant, and the project is for three years.
