Gift Women Link Foundation It is located at Kidodo; Kasese is center development region of Uganda. Since our organization is in establishing phase, its office is not well equipped. It is governed by an executive board of 5 members consisting of a president, a vice-president, one secretary, one treasurer and one executive member. Out of which all are females.

Gift Women Link Foundation (GWLF) is a compact team of women having tremendous vigor to overcome the socio-cultural, economic and political barriers for overall positive change for humanity. Team members are from different walks of life having common objectives towards social welfare and are experienced in their field. Nevertheless, it is the first time the team approached for the big project after its establishment though team has successfully accomplished small-scale projects on their own mobilizing local resources and international grants. Team is now running adult literacy skills voluntarily in its home location.

Our foundation **Achievements 2016**;

Registered success as for GWLF Kasese is as follows:

Education:

1 plot of land was purchased in Kidodo village for the construction of Vulnerable Children Digital Centre Project.

The Centre will offer ICT training to community target group. Currently we use rented buildings for GWLF training within the Municipality.

Health Facility: Currently GWLF implementing health care services, education, HIV/AIDS prevention, immunization, emergency cases, laboratory services and also we provide care and support for most vulnerable children living in risky environment in Kasese and kabarole districts.

These services are fully accessed at our **newly health outreach Centre** in Kabonero Sub County.

Women Vocational Skills Empowerment Project: To reduce youth poverty in Kasese municipality we already introduced tailoring project in which most youth and those most vulnerable children are undertaking secretarial, embroidery, arts and design skills, and tailoring training including promotion of manufactured clothing fashion marketing products.

This project was funded by Tools With A mission UK Within this project the GWLF is involved in capacity building of rural poor women and youth group and we need extension of vocational services and startup capital or Revolving fund to them also. We help the poor rural communities help themselves with the mission to empower and improve the poor people's opportunities to access skills to eradicate the root causes of poverty on local communities so as to enable them attain self-reliance sustainability through setting up their individual viable/profitable micro business to generate income for their families. Formal credit institutions e.g. commercial bank deem these rural poor women credit risks because they lack collateral consequently they have no access to the business loan to help their self-employed activities grow.

We plan to provide services to poor, low income women, youth and children especially rural clients lacking access to services and other financial institution.

So we have a distinct commitment to reaching the rural poor.

Capacity building

- 1) 1 youth empowerment project is launched that has youth vocational and technical business skills on how to manage business in conjunction with Act Women Foundation Kasese.
- 2) Training on computer maintenance and repair, electronics equipment's repair, Graphic design (adobe illustrator, adobe Photoshop, publisher and cover of books design) with African Ark College of management sciences.
- 3) More than 20 GWLF members were organized
- 4) 24hr Community health education and healthcare services accessibility at our newly health outreach Centre.
- 5) 2 community mobilization workshops were conducted.
- 6) Vocational skills training for orphans and vulnerable youth (carpentry, metal fabrication, welding, tailoring and carpentry).
- 7) Community development activities (ICT).
