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Mission



Our mission is to reduce poverty, marginalization, social and psychological constrictions in which vulnerable individuals, especially women, children, and people with refugees background or status. To overcome these significant conditions, MIBOSCO advocates for education, counseling and other activities and actions to empower and educate people in urban slum areas.

To achieve these, MIBOSCO our strategies are as follows:

- Collaborate with schools to increase children and youth awareness about their rights, health education, HIV/ AIDS prevention, social topics;
- Provide group / individual counseling to our beneficiaries;
- Provide free English classes and didactic support to schools and individuals;
- Empower and encourage women through seminars business / enterprenuership, meetings and other activities in order to make them more independent and aware about their rights;
- Form partnerships with local and international parties to share experiences and idea in order to improve our services to the community;
- Fundraising activities to support our projects, to provide food, clothes or any kind of help to our beneficiaries.















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MIBOSCO'S TEAM



MIBOSCO's team is composed by local and international volunteers with different study backgrounds some of them come for short or long period to offer their knowledge and skills to create a positive impact in the community. The staff plans its work in the office and then reaches directly the beneficiaries in the slum areas visiting constantly individuals, groups and schools.

The organization provides its services to the community thanks to volunteers from all around the world and survives only

through the support of both generous local and foreign individuals and organizations.

OUR PROJECTS

a) New Hope and Charity for Children (NHCC);

This program deals with orphans, destitute and children from poor families and currently we have 18 active children. In this program, children get access to education, connection with other children in the world through pen palling and they do learn many things from different experienced staff and interns; these include games, poem, dancing, agriculture etc...







b) Youth department:

This program involves the youths and deals with culture, drama, dance and bead art. They educate and inform about drug abuse, HIV/AIDS, Family planning, Peace and reconciliation.







c) Women United for Development (WUD);

The program is all about women empowerment. They are trained on business, enterprenuership, microfinance, community health (family planning, nutrition, HIV/AIDS).
