THE RULES OF PROCEDURE

OBSERVERS OF INTERNATIONAL NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS

Rule 70

- -International non-governmental organizations having an interest in the field of the environment international non-governmental organizations may make oral statements on matters within the approval of the United Nations Environment Assembly or of the subsidiary organ concerned Upon the invitation of the President or Chairperson, as the case may be, and subject to the scope of their activities.
