Genesis:

PAHEL is a non-government, not for profit, non-religious/faith, non-sectarian organization. In 2009 AD, it was established by a group of senior male and female human rights activists consist on educationists, doctors, legal experts, technocrats, dynamic entrepreneurs, enthusiastic students and effervescent youth and it was registered under the Societies Act 1860.

The group believed in a Chinese proverb that "A journey of thousand miles must begin with first step" Hence an initiative for social movement in the society was taken by the group and founded an association called PAHEL (PAHEL is an Urdu word that means an initiative)

PAHEL was formed the advocacy of upraised and helpless women, to up lift their social standard equal to the male, provide basic health facilities without any discrimination of caste and creed, take practicable measures for the protection of environment and provide a healthy environment to the upcoming generation & to literate society, keeping in view that a literate mother can prove the best mother for up bringing their children that why focus women literacy on priority.

PAHEL believes in the poverty alleviation of marginalized and excluded masses through inclusive approach and providing them equal and preferably priority to build their capacity and develop their skills, provide micro-financing to the skilled hands to establish their source of livelihoods and income generation activities.

PAHEL has emerged as a leading right based organization in Northern Sindh. It is not only striving hard for the protection and promotion of human rights in region but also echoing the unheard voices.




Aims & Objectives:

Structure of PAHEL






Core Values:

Advocacy & Awareness:

Currently PAHEL Pakistan is implementing a **USAID** funded project "Strengthen Voice of Citizens of District Shikarpur for Raising Voice against Mal-Administration and Redress of Grievances". The project is being implemented in the two districts of North Sindh, Shikarpur and Sukkur.



Human Rights & Democracy: Democracy Support Councils:

Beside that PAHEL Pakistan in collaboration of **Center for Human Rights Education Pakistan** has formed Democracy Support Councils in the two divisions of North Sindh, Sukkur and Larkana. After a capacity building package of 3 days training, this council is working in their areas, carrying out democracy and human rights supported activities with the support of PAHEL and CHRE Pakistan.



Protection and promotion of Human Rights:

PAHEL under the funding of National Endowment Fund for Democracy-NED is implementing a project for the protection and promotion of Human Rights and Democracy in Northern part of Sindh province. Human Rights Watch Groups-HRWGs have been established in the Sukkur division in its 1st phase





Education & Literacy:

PAHEL has established a primary level school "PAHEL Model School" at village Waheed Siyal, UC Agra, Tehsil Gambat, District Khairpur. The school has been linked with Sindh Education Foundation in its PPRS project. Initially there are 155 children (boys and girls) which are receiving education there.

Role of Youth in equality and Peace:

Action 2015 campaign is to educate, inspire and mobilize youth to take actions that empower marginalized people especially, older people, women and socially excluded groups to collectively voice against the root causes of poverty, inequality, gender based injustices and climate change in Pakistan.

Leading program of PAHEL

The leading program of PAHEL is:

"Promotion of Human rights, accountability of Government and preaching & tolerance in the society"

Such program is being implemented in the 04 districts Sukkur Division (Naoshehro Feroze, Khairpur, Sukkur and Ghotki) in year 2014-15 and 05 districts of Larkana Division (Larkana, Shikarpur, Qambar Shahdad Kot, Jacobabad and Kashmore Kandhkot) in year 2015-16 with the financial assistance of National Endowment Fund for Democracy-NED.

Under this program, Human Rights Watch Groups (HRWGs) are being formed in the each district which are comprises on 25-30 male/female/transgender youth. The groups are capacitated through 3 days training workshop for each group, focusing Human Rights and Democracy. On the 3rd day of the training the group elects their representatives as lead the group and elect District Coordinator, Deputy District Coordinator and General Secretary of group. Beside that a Plan of Action is developed which forward plan for putting the learning of the training into practice. After receiving training, the volunteer youth activists are playing their role as human rights defenders and promoters in their respective districts.

PAHEL has been conducting 5 days training workshop on interactive theatre for the interested members of HRWGs and after receiving training on theatre, they are performing theatre plays among such communities who have low literacy. They raise local issues of human rights and government performance through these theater performance.

PAHEL has been conducting various awareness and accountability programs like celebration of international days, echoing voice of unheard victims, responding human rights situations through walks, rallies, lecture, forums, seminars and public assemblies.

Human Rights Response

1. Terrorist Attack on Imam Bargah Shikarpur: PAHEL Pakistan has demonstrated Rally against the brutal killings of the Shiya sect of Muslims at Imam Bargah during Juma Prayer on January 31, 2015;

The incident took place on Friday noon at Shiya Imam Bargah Shikarpur on January 30, 2015. The rally was started from Qadir Bux Bedil Library, passing through Shikarpur press club, Lakhi Gate and went to the Imam Bargah (the place of indecent); the participants condemned the coward act of terrorism.

The Human Rights Watch Group, PAHEL Pakistan, Civil Societies, Political Leaders, Students, teachers participated in the rally to condemn the brutal killings of peoples during prayer time at Imam Bargah Shikarpur.



2. Token Hunger Strike against brutal attack on Imam Bargah at Shikarpur: PAHEL Pakistan and Centre for Human Rights Education in collaboration with civil society hold token hunger strike on February 7, 2015 as to condemn the brutal terrorist attack on Imam bargah, during Juma prayer on 30th Jan-2015 and demand prompt army action in district Shikarpur against the terrorists, their local like minds and





facilitators. The token hunger strike started from 11:00 am to 02:00 pm in front of Shikarpur Press Club. The strike and demand was endorsed and attended by Centre for Human Rights Education Pakistan, Amman-o-Ravadari Sangat, Civil Society Network, Human Rights Watch Group (Sukkur, Ghotki, Khairpur and Naushehro Feroze). Beside that the local faces who are the like minded to the religious extremists, provide local facilitation for carrying out terrorist attacks in Shikarpur district and deliver hate speeches.

3. Terrorists attack on Church at Youhanabad, Lahore: PAHEL Pakistan has demonstrated a rally against terrorist attack on two churches of youhanabad "Catholic Church and

Christ church" Lahore on March 15, 2015; the participants were from different religions and sects, political leader, civil society and students to protest against the losses of innocent peoples. The rally was started from Qadir Bux Bedil Library to clock tower Shikarpur. PAHEL Pakistan team with collaboration of civil society strongly condemned such type attacks to innocent peoples and it is also demanded that the Government should implement their Action Plan; religious extremism and intolerance was also condemned during the rally.



Oath for Peace

PAHEL Pakistan in collaboration of Centre for Human Rights Education carried our peace activities in the project area districts and Shikar pur as well. This collaborative efforts maximize the impact and outreach of the activity.



The most important work that PAHEL has been doing is

"Preaching and promotion of peace, tolerance and co-existence"

Growing intolerance especially religious intolerance in Pakistan is pushing society into more and complex situation and loses which are irreparable. Until now more than 70 thousand people have lost their lives by becoming victim of bomb explosion, hundreds lost their lives in blasphemy accusation, many religious places and Christian worship places and residential areas are burnt into ashes. The point of concern is this that this religious intolerance is growing more rapidly having strangled hold on society. Though government has started realizing the sensitivity of the issue and took some step like National Action Plan, execution of capital punishment of the criminals waiting for capital punishment etc but this only is not sufficient. Country is in the state of war against terrorism and religious and extremism. Army and Government are playing their role but wars are not won by the army or by the state, it is the nation who supports them morally and stands shoulder by shoulder with them as keep their moral high.

Realizing the role of civil society in Pakistan, PAHEL Pakistan taking in collaboration to Centre for Human Rights Education Pakistan planned a joined venture to response the situation and spread the message of peace, tolerance and co-existence

PAHEL Pakistan decided to take Rwadari (Tolerance) Caravan from Lahore (a capital city of Punjab) to Shikarpur (a city of Sindh) in collaboration with CHRE. All the interested activists throughout Pakistan were invited to join the caravan. Beside that the Rawadari Caravan was advertised on official pages of PAHEL Pakistan. The planned caravan will also be supported by the series of the activities as mentioned below:

- i. Inauguration ceremony and press briefing of Rwadari Caravan at Press Club Lahore on March 9th, 2015.
- ii. Journey of Rawadari Caravan-Lahore to Shikarpur on March 10th, 2015
- Press Briefing of Rawadari Caravan and other clipped the activities at Sukkur Press club on March 11th, 2015
- iv. Good will exchange visits: Church, Imam Bargah, Sadh Belo Sukkur on March 11th, 2015
- v. Visit of Dargah Bedil Bekus Rohri-Sukkur and Sufi-Folk music that teaches the message love, peace, tolerance and co-existence on March 11th, 2015.
- vi. Peace Rally from Qasim Park to Sukkur Press Club on March 12th, 2015
- vii. Rawadari Festival-2015 at Public School Sukkur on March 13th, 2015
- viii. Rawadari Caravan to Shikarpur on March 14th , 2015
