- Support boys' education by sourcing funds and resources for academic advancement.
- Promote leadership and civic engagement by involving boys in community service and leadership development programs.





# TARGET AREAS

## ■ Personal Development & Life Skills

Enhancing boys' self-esteem and confidence through structured programs and advocating for policy and social changes that address systemic barriers.

## ■ Health & Well-being

Providing rehabilitation and counseling services in a supportive, homely environment that promotes healing and growth.

## ■ Education & Literacy

Increasing access to quality education and academic opportunities to ensure every boy reaches his full potential.

## ■ Community Engagement & Leadership

Promoting mentorship, leadership training, and positive role modeling to build responsible and community-minded young men.



# ANNUAL ACTIVITIES

## ■ Boys Empowerment Summit (January)

A conference focused on mentorship, role modeling, talent development, and goal-setting, with an emphasis on policy advocacy for the boy child.

## ■ International Boy's Day Commemoration (16th May)

A special event recognizing the challenges and potential of the boy child, featuring activities, awareness campaigns, and community engagement.

## ■ Reformation and Empowerment Campaign (May to December)

A school- and community-based outreach targeting high school boys, focused on character formation, mental health, anti-drug education, life skills, and positive masculinity.

## ■ End-of-Year Charity Outreach (December)

An initiative where Boy Child Advocacy gives back to communities through service, donations, and support for vulnerable groups, fostering empathy and social responsibility.


