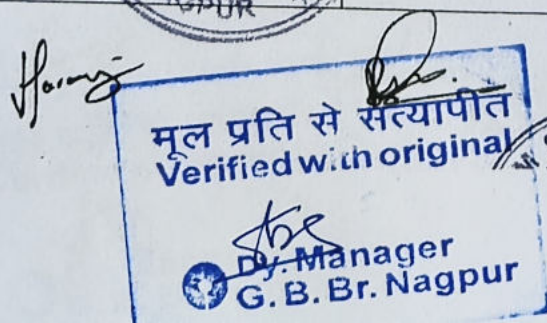

1. RULES AND REGULATION OF "GRAM SEWA SANGH "NAGPUR**(AMENDED)**

1.	SOCIETY MEANS	GRAM SEWA SANGH, NAGPUR.
2.	PRESIDENT MEANS	THE PRESIDENT OF 'GRAM SEWA SANGH, NAGPUR.'
3.	VICE-PRESIDENT MEANS	THE VICE PRESIDENT OF 'GRAM SEWA SANGH, NAGPUR.'
4.	SECRETARY MEANS	THE SECRETARY OF 'GRAM SEWA SANGH, NAGPUR.'
5.	JOINT SECRETARY MEANS	THE JOINT SECRETARY OF 'GRAM SEWA SANGH, NAGPUR.'
6.	TRESURER MEANS	THE TRESURER OF 'GRAM SEWA SANGH, NAGPUR.'
7.	EXECUTIVE MEMBERS MEANS	EXECUTIVE MEMBERS MEANS OF THE 'GRAM SEWA SANGH, NAGPUR.'

2. JURIDICTION -

The jurisdiction of the society shall be throughout the state of Maharashtra State.

3. ACCOUNT YEAR -

Account year of the society shall be 1st April to 31st March of every year.

4. MEMBERSHIP & ENROLMENT -

A person having the age of more than 18 years can be a member of the society. Who has to become a member, has to make an application on prescribed form. After acceptance membership application by the Governing body, membership fee will accepted. The decision of the Governing Body will be final.

5. CATEGORIES OF MEMBERSHIP -**A] FOUNDER MEMBER -**

The member of the first Governing body who has signed the Memorandum of Association shall be the founder member.

B] LIFE MEMBER -

One who contribute Rs.501/- in lump sum shall be the life member of the association

C] DONOR MEMBER -

One who contributes Rs.201/- in lump sum shall be the donor member of the association.

D] ORDINARY MEMBER

Those who will contribute Rs.10/- monthly shall be the ordinary member of the association. Such ordinary member shall have to pay Rs.5/- as Enrollment fee.

6. RULES REGULATION DISMEMBERSHIP -

- I. If he remains absent for 3 meetings consecutively without intimation.
- II. If his behavior proves to be harmful in the interest of the Association.
- III. If his behavior appears against the rules of Association.
- IV. If the Ordinary Members will not pay the membership fees within 3 months after completion of the year, his membership will be ceased automatically.

7. POWER AND DUTIES OF THE GENERAL BODY -

- I. To take the final decision.
- II. To pass the budget and audit report produced before meetings.
- III. To help the Governing Body in the working of the Association.
- IV. To prepare or amend the constitution.
- V. To elect Governing Body in its Annual General Meeting.

8. NOTICE AND QUORUM OF GENERAL BODY -

Notice for the meeting of General Body will be served 15 days earlier. Notice must mention date, time, place and agenda of the meeting of Notice. Notice will be given through hand delivery book, it will be sent by Registration Post with Acknowledgement due.

The quorum for the meeting will be 2/3 of the total members. Any adjourned meeting due to lack of quorum shall be held at the same place after an hour on the same day. No quorum is required for the adjourned meeting

9. EXTRA ORDINARY MEETING OF GENERAL BODY. POWER & DUTY -


An extra ordinary meeting of General Body can be called as and when required, Agenda will be discussed only for which the meeting was called for 10 days notice is necessary. Notice will be given through Hand - delivery Book by taking signatures in token of acknowledgement and if not accepted through hand delivery Book, the same will be sent 1/5 of the total members of General Body. Adjourned meeting will be held after an hour at the same place on the same day.

10. COMPOSITION FOR GOVERNING BODY -

The Governing body shall be consists of:

- I. President
- II. Vice-president
- III. Secretary
- IV. Joint Secretary
- V. Treasurer and
- VI. Others Members.

The Governing body will be of minimum 7 and not more than 15 members.

11. TENURE & ELECTION OF GOVERNING BODY -

The first Governing Body will be held in the office for first 5 years, and then election will be held after every five years. Election will be held in the General Body Meeting by Secret Ballot System.

12. POWERS & DUTIES OF OFFICE BEARERS -

- I. President:-To conduct the proceedings of the meeting, to issue appropriate orders for the benefit of the society, to control the proceedings of the society and to arrange General Body Meeting, to give casting vote.
- II. Vice-president:-To holds the responsibilities in the absence of the president, to help him in all respects in working of the society.
- III. Secretary:-
 - i. To call meetings of Governing Body and General Body to the society, to correspondence.
 - ii. Entertain the complaints.
 - iii. To maintain the proceedings of the society.
 - iv. To prepare Annual Accounts and put forward for approval before General Body.
 - v. To maintain and prepare daily accounts.
 - vi. To approve bills.
 - vii. To execute the approved proposals.
 - viii. To do anything in the interest of the society.
 - ix. To issue notices of the meetings with the consent of the president.
- IV. Joint-Secretary:-

To acts as secretary in the absence of the secretary, and to help him in his duties.
- V. Treasurer:-

To keep appropriate accounts, to get signed by secretary, to prepare final accounts, to collect donations, funds, subscriptions, etc.
- VI. Other Members:-

To attend the General Body and Governing Body meetings to vote in the working of the society, to call General meeting for any suggestion by making requisition to the secretary.

13. MEETING OF GOVERNING BODY & REQUISITION MEETING -

At least 4 meetings will be held within a year and on requisition of 3 or 4 members of Governing Body.

14. NOTICE & QUORUM OF GOVERNING BODY MEETING -

The notice of the meeting be served 7 days in advance; notice for the requisition meeting will be served 3 days earlier. Notice must reflect the date, time, place and agenda of the meeting called for.

Quorum for the meeting will be 2/3 of the total members. Quorum for requisition meeting will be 3/5 of total members. No quorum is required for adjourned meeting. Adjourned meeting will be held on the same day at the same place after an hour.

15. RULES REGARDING ELECTION -

The members having sort of arrears of fees shall not be eligible for voting. A member having membership continuously for one year can vote.

16. FILING OF VACANCY -

Any vacancy arises due to death, resignation or any other reason shall be filled in by the majority votes for the remaining period.

17. POWERS AND DUTIES OF GOVERNING BODY -

- I. To take out the object of the society.
- II. To select the members for execution of the various program.
- III. To collect funds.
- IV. To prepare and execute the programs as approved by General Body.
- V. To cancel or to suspend the membership of any member if any his behavior proves to be harmful in the interest of the society.
- VI. To maintain the minute books of the meeting of Governing Body and General Body.
- VII. To maintain the discipline and efficiency in the working of the society.
- VIII. To pass the Annual Budget and the Audit Reports of the society.
- IX. To accept the resignation.

18. SOURCE OF INCOME AND FUNDS AND UTILISATION -

Membership fees, subscriptions, donations, Govt. Grants, will be the source of income. The funds will be utilized on the objects of the society.

19. PERCENTAGE OF EXPENSES ON OBJECTS -

The allocation % of instant society will be 50% on educational, 30% on medical and 20% on charitable objects.

20. PROVISIONS REGARDING LOAN/DEPOSITS -

At the time of taking loan from any person or from bank, necessary prior permission from the Joint Charity Commissioner, Nagpur will be obtained.

21. PROVISIONS REGARDING SALE/PURCHASE OF PROPERTY -

At the time of sale of property or purchase of property, necessary prior permission from the Joint Charity Commissioner, Nagpur will be obtained.

22. BANK ACCOUNT -

Bank account of the society shall be opened jointly by the president and either secretary or treasurer of the society.

23. LIST OF MEMBERS -

List of the members as required under the section 15 of the Societies Registration (Maharashtra) rule, 1971, Act 1860, shall be maintained in the Schedule 6 prescribed under Rules 15 of the Societies Registration (Maharashtra) rule, 1971.

24. AMENDMENTS TO CONSTITUTIONS -

Any changes in the constitution can be made by 3/5th majority in the General Body Meeting. Procedure as laid down in Section 12 of the Societies Registration Act, 1860 shall be followed.

25. AMENDMENT OF OBJECTS/CHANGE IN THE NAME -

As and when the change in the object /or change in the name of the society is to be amalgamated wholly with other society, the procedure laid down in the section 12 and 12A of the Societies Registration Act, 1860 shall be followed.

26. DISSOLUTION -

★ In the event of dissolution of the Gram Sewa Sangh, Nagpur, the General Body Meeting should be called and the resolution should be passed in it by the majority of 3/5th members present at that time. The entire trust funds shall be realized and first be used for payment of liabilities of the Gram Sewa Sangh, Nagpur. The assets left in any, shall be disbursed to other Trust or Associations having similar objectives after obtaining previous approval of Commissioner of Income Tax and in no event it shall be distributed in any manner, to any of the Board of Trustees or their relatives or related concerns. The Society can be dissolved in accordance with Section 13 and 14 of the Societies Registration Act, 1860.

27. FUNDS & ASSETS / PROPERTIES & FUNDS -

The funds and assets / properties of the trust will be used only for the objectives of the trust.

29. IRREVOCABLE -

The trust is registered as per the provisions of the Societies Registration Act 1860 and subsequently registered under the Maharashtra Public Trust Act 1950 as a deemed trust and the trust is irrevocable.
