BACKGROUND OF THE ORGANIZATION

Arasan Rural Development Society was founded by a group of dedicated social workers in the year 1988. ARDS was originally organized as an organization by name Arasan Vidhyalaya with emphasis on promoting education and impartiing vocational training to poor girls. The members of the organization felt that it was necessary to work for the welfare of all sections and categories of the rural disadvantaged communities and hence the name of the organization was changed as Arasan Rural Development Society (ARDS) in the year 1995. Then onwards, ARDS began to function as a rural development NGO and carry out various activities for the overall development of the rural community.

Initially, ARDS was functioning with only a few staff with minimum resources. There were only 3 vocational instructors and 2 tutors carrying out vocational training in typewriting, shorthand, tailoring and coaching classes for SSLC failed candidates. From 1992 onwards ARDS started receiving Government support for implementing vocational training and awareness generation programs. We have implemented Vocational Training Programme in Typewriting benefiting 100 girls each year aided by Central Social Welfare Board, Project for Promotion of Small Family Norm and Population Control aided by Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Awareness Building Programme on Alcoholism aided by Ministry of Welfare, Workshop on Dowry Problem aided by Dept. of Women & Child Development, National Integration Campaign, TRYSEM Programmes, Construction of Low cost latrines, Provision of Smokeless Chulahs, Oldage Home for Older Persons aided by Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Short Stay Home for Women & Girls in distress aided by Central Social Welfare Board, Family Counseling Centre by Central Social Welfare Board, REDP in Readymade garments making to rural poor women aided by NABARD, SHG Formation & Linkage Project aided by NABARD Chennai, Micro Credit Program aided by Rashtriya Mahila Kosh, New Delhi, Minorities Development & Finance Corporation New Delhi, Computer Training Programme to poor girls aided by Central Social Welfare Board and Balwady Education Project aided by Castricum Muttatharah, Netherlands, Child Labour Rehabilitation Project by Wild Ganzon, Netherlands, Swadhar Shelter Home for abandoned women aided by the Ministry of Women & Child Development New Delhi, SHGs formation & linkage by Tamil Nadu Corporation for Development of Women Ltd. Chennai, Project for the Rehabilitation of the Disabled by District Disabled Rehabilitation Officer, Tirunelveli.

- 2. To give free Vocational education in Typewriting, Shorthand, Computer, Accountancy and Tailoring to poor girls.
- 3. To conduct moral instruction classes to the children.
- 4. To instill modern outlook and ideas in the minds of the girls as found by "Puratchi Kavi Bharathiyar".
- 5. To show ways and means for the deserving students to derive the benefits and scholarships granted by the Government.
- 6. To help the educated unemployed women by free supply of employment newspapers and help them in applying for employment.

- 7. To evince interest in women education and up liftment of women and raising their standard.
- 8. To work for the upliftment of suppressed poor girls and for the welfare of the girls and raise their status in the society.
- 9. To work for the upliftment of the poor and downtrodden women.
- 10. To take up activities for the most deserving and weaker section of our community like handicapped of all categories, aged and lepers in the promotion of social, economical and psychological rehabilitation.
- 11. To undertake programs and schemes for the promotion of and eco-development in all aspects.
- 12. To serve for the promotion of health, sanitation, population controls and to conduct awareness camps on all the related subjects.
- 13. To help the rural poor by providing facilities like free housing, low-cost sanitation systems, formal and non-formal education, vocational rehabilitation and counseling centers to aware about their social rights.
- 14. To help rural poor by organizing Youth clubs, Mahalir Mantrams, Recreation clubs, National Integrity and Community Centers, Self-Help Groups and Thrift societies to avail loans from Government and other funding agencies.
- 15. To mobilize funds from both State and Central Government Embassies and Consulates of all countries, Royal kingdoms and the funding agencies of Global level for the implementation of welfare activities for the community people.
- 16. To serve for the welfare of human, irrespective of caste, creed, race, community sex and religion by running welfare schemes in India and the activities shall not be carried on outside India.
- 17. To promote the spirit of National Integration Patriotism, Communal Harmony and religious tolerance among the children youth and every men and women.
- 18. To improve the Socio Economic Development of Rural/Urban poor women and uplift backward weaker sections of the society by forming Self-Help Groups and by implementing income generation activities.
- 19. To adopt the orphaned / Semi-Orphaned / discarded and other poor children and run Children's Home.
