### 1. Organization Overview

**Sector Focus:** Child protection, education, psychosocial support, humanitarian assistance, social inclusion, advocacy, and livelihoods

#### About YGODC:

YGODC is an independent Sudanese humanitarian organization dedicated to addressing the urgent needs of vulnerable children and communities across Sudan. The organization operates in conflict-affected, displaced, and socially marginalized settings, including schools, displacement sites, refugee camps, and communities affected by poverty or social breakdown.

The organization prioritizes **children who are most at risk**, including displaced and refugee children, street-connected children, children in conflict with the law, children with disabilities, orphans, and children lacking primary family care.

#### Mission:

  - **Sustainability:** Promoting long-term solutions that enhance child and community resilience.

### 3. Organizational Mandate

YGODC operates under a **child-centered, rights-based, and community-driven mandate** with the following pillars:

1. **Child Protection and Safeguarding:** Implement policies and programs to protect children from all forms of violence, exploitation, neglect, and abuse.
  2. **Education and Skills Development:** Ensure access to formal and non-formal education, vocational training, and life skills development.
  3. **Humanitarian Assistance:** Provide emergency support including food, shelter, clothing, hygiene, medical, and psychosocial services.
  4. **Economic and Social Empowerment:** Build the resilience of children and families through livelihood initiatives, skills training, and micro-project support.
  5. **Advocacy and Awareness:** Promote child rights, social inclusion, and behavior change through community mobilization, campaigns, and policy engagement.
  6. **Community Engagement:** Empower children and communities to participate in decision-making and program design for sustainable outcomes.
