Travel bursary to attend Clinton Global Initiative University at The University of Edinburgh

Congratulations on your invitation from the Clinton Global Initiative University to attend CGI U at University of Edinburgh from 17-19 April 2020. As part of the University of Edinburgh commitment to promoting global citizenship, **I am delighted to offer you a bursary of up to £1290 towards your travel costs.** This bursary is intended to cover: Flight and insurance from Nigeria £750; visa (if needed), airport transfers, accommodation in Edinburgh £320; food and local transport £120.

This bursary is conditional on all of the following:

- You must attend a preparatory workshop on the morning of Friday 17 April 2020 and the full programme of CGI U (that is be published at <https://www.clintonfoundation.org/clinton-global-initiative/meetings/cgi-university>) and allow adequate time for travel.
- Your CGI U Commitment to Action has project and risk management process appropriate for the types of activities involved. If there is a significant risk to you or others, you will revise the CGI U Commitment to Action to fully mitigate that risk.
- You have adequate travel insurance.
- You have valid travel documents and any visas needed.
- You are fully responsible for your own personal safety and making logistical arrangements including flights and accommodation. This is not an organised field trip.
- You commit to respond fully and on time to post-event reports and evaluation requests from the University and CGIU.
- You commit to give full feedback and contribute to articles (or other media) about your experiences of CGI U.
- The bursary is not transferred to other uses or to other people.

To receive the bursary, please complete the attached form and email it to Global.Admin@ed.ac.uk by Friday 17 January 2020. In requesting the bursary, you agree to the above conditions and late submission of the funding form can result in non-payment. If you do not wish to receive the bursary let us know as soon as possible so that we can offer the funding to another student.

Should you need a visa to enter the United Kingdom, we can provide a letter of invitation to support your visa application. To request a letter of invitation please complete the attached form and email it to Global.Admin@ed.ac.uk. Please check the timelines for visa applications – this can take longer than you expect.

This bursary is supported by the Principal's Fund. We hope that several University of Edinburgh online students will be attending (possibly up to 15!); and that this will be a great experience for you all.
