FDR AFRICA uses program clubs to deepen community awareness

In order to deepen the listenership and participation of women and youth, FDR AFRICA in 2015 piloted the establishment of Radio Listenership program in Oyam where Community Based Monitors mobilized people (men & women) around a radio set at a given location in a parish/ village and listen to a community program together with other community members.



With a view to provide evidence based advocacy and recommendations for adoption by relevant institutions in Northern Uganda, These have been an input for FDR AFRICA to widen Oyam civil society advocacy. Based on a range of feedback from the target audience, the publications have increased public awareness on socio-economic and policy issues, public accountability and other effective service delivery
