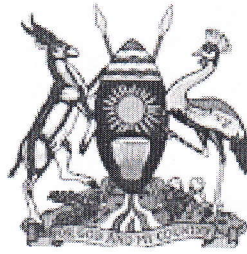
I am a Ugandan citizen aged 42 years old. I acquired duo citizenship in the USA since 2002.

RE: LAUNCHING OF MOTHERS OF PEACE PROJECT IN BUGIRI DISTRICT.

In 2012, I led a delegation from Bugiri District for a developmental visit in the United States of America (USA), of which we participated in a number of Developmental activities and conferences in different states; this included but not limited to advocacy and lobbying for funds, meetings with Government officials, discussing and concluding project funding for mothers of peace project in Bugiri District, supported by Rotary International, specifically Del Mar-salon Beach, sunrise Rotary Club, La Jolla Golden Triangle Rotary Club, Rancho Bernardo (San Diego) Rotary club, Riverside East Rotary Club and Rotary Club of Jinja Uganda.

Bugiri District Local Government in Conjunction with Integrated Science and Education for African Communities (ISEAC) a US registered non-profitable and a Uganda based Registered Non-Governmental Organization with branch offices in Uganda, working towards a Self-sufficient and sustainable African Community that has social amenities and other basics of life, are implementing a project "**Mothers of Peace Project**" as a result of the violent civil war between the government of Uganda and the Lord's Resistance Army (LRA) that had plagued the Northern region of the country into violence. The Project has established programs in the technical training for neglected former female child soldiers of war and their children in Uganda. All courses and programs focus at creating income generating opportunities and foster psychological healing by providing technical skills and emotional counselling for female ex-child soldiers who are also now mothers. It is hoped that it will build the human and intellectual capacity of youths and vulnerable communities to obtain formal employment or create self-employment.

The purpose of this letter therefore, is to invite you as a guest of honour to launch and officiate the opening of the project in Bugiri on 16th of March 2013, at exactly 12:00pm at ISEAC Offices Next to Bugiri Police Headquarters.
