

Reccomendation of Twene Mbee Networking and Development Group.

This is to confirm that Twene Mbee Networking and Development group was registered on 31st October 2006 and is mandated to work in Makueni County. Twene Mbee partnered with St John's community centre during the Period 2013 -2016 in implementing a program for Orphans and Vulnerable children. The program targeted Local Implementing partners (LIPs) like Twene Mbee with technical abilities in reaching out to Orphans and Vulnerable Children.

During the 3 years of partnering with Twene Mbee; they demonstrated capacity in financial management, strategic planning, managing grants and resources, and sustainability of their organization.

In the area of Orphans and vulnerable children in partnership with St John's Community Centre; Twene mbee implemented the following activities:

- a) Offering Apprenticeship training of out of school orphans to ensure they become self reliant.
- b) Improving vulnerable Households economically through income generating activities.
- c) Offering psychosocial support to Orphans and Vulnerable children through the school structures.
- d) Ensuring child protection within their area of operation through the Area Advisory council of the Children's department.
- e) Ensuring improved health status of Orphans and vulnerable children through household visits and regular monthly review by the Community Health Workers.
