About REACH

REACH is a Vietnamese non profit organization registered with VUSTA (Vietnam Union of Science and Technology Associations). REACH specialises in vocational training and employment for Vietnam's most disadvantaged youth.

From 2004 to 2017, REACH helped more than 14,000 disadvantaged young people receive vocational training.

Our vocational training and job placement model works because we:

- Match our training to industry needs
- Teach our students English and soft skills they will need in the workplace
- Instill our students with good work habits and a positive attitude
- Support our students for 6 months after their graduation to make sure they find and keep a job
- Provide practical training. We work closely with businesses to carry out regular assessments of the job market; we also include industry guest lectures, develop our curriculum based on real-world situations, continually assess the quality of our programs and provide internship and job opportunities

Since 2004, REACH has developed a wide network of nearly 1,000 businesses who train and employ our students, including the Br24, Cennos, Esoflow, Fusion Maia Resort, Hilton Hotels & Resorts, Hong Duyen Salon, Intercontinental Hotels Group, Laguna, M unrise Resort and hundreds of other large and small domestic and international enterprises.



Our Students

REACH helps disadvantaged youth between the ages of 16-30, who do not have access to formal vocational training programs because of barriers such as poverty, lack of education, and difficult family circumstances.

Our students include street and migrant youth, school dropouts, unemployed secondary school graduates, disadvantaged youth from ethnic minorities, and youth who have just left the army.

We also cater to marginalized groups such as trafficked survivors victims of domestic violence, as well as those living with or affected by HIV and persons living with disabilities.

Our Programs

LABS (Livelihood Advancement Business School): provides 3-6 month intensive training courses in various disciplines including Food & Beverage, Housekeeping, Sales & Marketing, Graphic Design, Cooking, Hairdressing & Nail painting, 3D Modelling, Web coding and Spa Therapy & Makeup.

YCI (Youth Career Initiative): provides 24 weeks of hospitality training with 70% of training given onsite by leading 5-star hotels. It is intended to be a low-cost program, utilising available resources in the private sector to deliver intensive on-the-job training.

Step Up: provides Life skills, English lessons, Physical training and Vocational skills to people living with visual impairment. It is created to improve confidence and skills resulting in better access to community integration and more secured employment opportunities.

Social Enterprises: REACH has built Social Enterprise Models that provide on-the-job training and experience for REACH students. 100% of the profits from all of our Social Enterprises are used to help disadvantaged young people who are studying at REACH. These include:
