- A Learning Center to empower youth and women in Media, ICT, and Bible Studies (School of Ministry) towards career and spiritual growth.
- Consecrated departments of youth, women, and men for the development of leadership and economic empowerment.

Since our establishment in 2013, with strong vision-led leadership, we have been dedicated to the advancement of economic empowerment, faith-based leadership, and sustainable development. We have evolved over the years into a multifaceted nonprofit making organization, which includes:

- A church and outreach ministry dedicated to nurturing faith, character, and community influence.
- A Learning Center for training in Media, ICT, and Bible Studies (School of Ministry) to impart spiritual knowledge and practical skills.
- Empowerment programs for youth, women, and men to foster leadership and economic self-sustainability.
- A family cluster network built on strong Christian values, support, and spiritual growth at home.

With all these efforts, we remain committed to building opportunities, constructing solid families, and shaping meaningful individuals who make an impact on society.

Mission

Our mission is to equip vulnerable youth and women in Uganda with marketable skills, spiritual grounding, and leadership experience to become independent contributors to society. We accomplish this by providing:

- Whole-person education through experiential training and personal development.
- Faith-based mentorship reinforces moral and spiritual grounding.

These centers will empower youth and women with practical, marketable skills to enhance employability, promote entrepreneurship, and strengthen family economic stability. Additionally, the centers will serve as hubs for leadership development and personal growth, offering recreational and rehabilitative support to those in need hence fostering purpose-driven, transformed lives.

3. Microfinance & Economic Empowerment Initiatives

To promote self-sufficiency and financial independence, we will launch microfinance projects, including:

- **Village Savings & Loan Associations (VSLA)** to encourage savings and small-scale investments.
- **Financial literacy training** to equip beneficiaries with knowledge in budgeting, savings, and business management.

4. Leadership Development Programs

We are committed to raising a generation of purpose-driven servant leaders through structured leadership development embedded within our youth and women's programs. These initiatives will:

- Equip individuals with biblical leadership principles to positively influence their families, communities, and workplaces.

In line with this vision, we plan to establish a Youth Development Center on 6 acres of land in Wakiso District, Uganda. This center will serve as both a recreational and rehabilitation hub, offering a safe space for transformation and personal growth. More importantly, it will be a training ground for youth leadership, where young people will be equipped with the skills, mindset, and practical knowledge needed to become self-reliant, resourceful, and impactful members of society.

5. Health and Well-being Initiatives

Holistic development includes physical and mental well-being. Our initiatives will include:

- Medical camps offer essential healthcare services to underserved communities.
- Counseling and mental health support to promote emotional resilience.
- Health education programs focus on nutrition, hygiene, and disease prevention.

6. Collaborative Partnerships

To amplify our impact, we will forge strategic partnerships with:

- Local and international organizations for resource-sharing and program expansion.
- Churches, NGOs, and corporate partners to enhance funding and community outreach.
- Educational institutions provide scholarships, internships, and skill-based programs.

We plan to introduce sustainable farming initiatives to:

7. Music & Worship Development Center

We envision establishing a **Music & Worship Development Center** dedicated to nurturing the gifts and talents of young worshipers. This center will provide a creative and spiritual space where youth can grow in their calling as worship leaders and musicians. Key components of the center will include:

- A **professional recording studio** where young worshipers can write, compose, and record original worship music.
- **Workshops and mentorship programs** led by experienced worship leaders, songwriters, and producers to guide the development of musical and spiritual skills.
- Opportunities for youth to **produce and launch worship albums**, gaining exposure and sharing their message of faith and hope with a wider audience.
- A platform for live **worship events, concerts, and training sessions** that inspire and equip the next generation of worship leaders.

This center will not only amplify the voices of young worshipers but also strengthen the spiritual fabric of communities through heartfelt, homegrown worship.

8. Global Prayer Altar (Prayer Mountain)

We are committed to establishing a Prayer Altar in the form of a Prayer Mountain—a sacred and serene space where individuals, families, and ministry groups can come to seek God in prayer, fasting, and spiritual renewal. This mountain will serve as a global intercession hub, drawing people from all parts of the world to experience the power of prayer and divine encounters. Key features of the Prayer Altar will include:

- Designated prayer cabins, worship spaces, and retreat areas for personal and corporate intercession.
- Organized prayer conferences, fasting programs, and spiritual retreats throughout the year.
- A peaceful, natural environment that fosters intimacy with God, spiritual breakthrough, and restoration.

This Prayer Mountain will be a place of revival, healing, and transformation, empowering believers to return to their communities refreshed and spiritually empowered.

9. Visit Africa (Uganda): Global Volunteer & Missions Platform

Through our Visit Africa (Uganda) initiative, we are creating a global platform for volunteers, missionaries, and partners to travel to Uganda and actively support the impactful work we are doing in communities. Ensuring Sustainable Growth & Impact at The Jabez Foundation

To achieve long-term sustainability, expand our programs, and maximize our impact, The Jabez Foundation has developed a structured resource mobilization strategy. This approach ensures that we have the necessary financial, human, and material resources to empower communities, transform lives, and strengthen faith-based development initiatives.

1. DIVERSIFIED FUNDING SOURCES
